We ask you about what products you use, and how you use them. As we do not know who you are, we can't and won't tie answers to personal information about you.

We will use this survey to help us prioritize product features, learn about the most relevant type of customer, and learn how to better communicate about the product.

Will you disclose my response to anyone else?

The full survey results are not public, though we may publish excerpts. Such public results could for example be, "85% of our respondents said they use product X".

Introduction

- Files are never stored in the cloud, so both the sender and receiver need to be online at the same time during the file transfer.
- It is identity-less and quick: you do not need to sign up for an account or give your or the receiver's contact info to send a file.

- With end-to-end encryption, you keep your data private to yourself and the receiver. The provider cannot open your files.
- You can send very large files of up to 10 GB, through a website and mobile/desktop apps.
